## CHAPTER 84.

AN ACT to compensate George Y. Maynadier and William Young for legal services rendered the State.

Issue war-

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the treasurer for the payment to George Y. Maynadier and William Young, of the sum of three hundred dollars, for compensation for services rendered in the trial of the mandamus case of Louis Cahen versus A. Lingan Jarrett, Clerk of the Circuit Court for Harford county, in the Circuit Court for Harford county and in the Court of Appeals, which said sum of three hundred dollars is hereby appropriated for that purpose.

## CHAPTER 85.
