CHAPTER 92.

AN ACT entitled a supplement to the act entitled "An act to incorporate the Presbyterian Church of the city of Baltimore," passed at November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-seven, chapter fifty-eight, and authorizing said corporation to hold and acquire property to the value of four hundred thousand dollars.

Whereas, by the act to which this is a supplement, the body politic thereby created was empowered to acquire and hold property not exceeding in value the sum of six thousand dollars, which limit was extended to twenty-five thousand dollars by the act of eighteen hundred and fifty-six, chapter three hundred and thirty-one, and was still further extended to one hundred and fifty thousand dollars by the act of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter two

ble. And Whereas a still further extension of said limit has become necessary.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the said corporation may hold and acquire, by purchase, gift, devise or bequest, real or personal property; provided the same shall not exceed in value the sum of four hundred thousand dollars.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
