

## CHAPTER 92.

AN ACT entitled a supplement to the act entitled "An act to incorporate the Presbyterian Church of the city of Baltimore," passed at November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-seven, chapter fifty-eight, and authorizing said corporation to hold and acquire property to the value of four hundred thousand dollars.

Preamble. WHEREAS, by the act to which this is a supplement, the body politic thereby created was empowered to acquire and hold property not exceeding in value the sum of six thousand dollars, which limit was extended to twenty-five thousand dollars by the act of eighteen hundred and fifty-six, chapter three hundred and thirty-one, and was still further extended to one hundred and fifty thousand dollars by the act of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter two hundred and twenty-five;

Preamble. AND WHEREAS a still further extension of said limit has become necessary.

May hold and acquire. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the said corporation may hold and acquire, by purchase, gift, devise or bequest, real or personal property; provided the same shall not exceed in value the sum of four hundred thousand dollars.

Effective. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
