SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

CHAPTER 97.

AN ACT to repeal and to re-enact section fifty-five of article fifteen of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Montgomery county," sub-title "Rockville," as enacted by chapter one hundred and seventy of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section fifty-five of article fifteen of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled "Montgomery county," sub-title "Rockville," as enacted by chapter one hundred and seventy of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy, be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following section and sub-sections be and they are hereby enacted in lieu thereof.

SECTION 55. The County Commissioners for Montgomery county shall, at their first meeting in the month of May next, appoint three judges of election for the town of Rockville, who shall be substantial citizens and residents in the corporate limits of said town for at least three years next preceding their appointment. The judges of election so appointed shall give at least three weeks previous notice in the newspapers published in Rockville, of the time and place of holding an election for three commissioners for Rockville, which day of election shall be
