

CHAPTER 99.

AN ACT to fix the fees of Collectors of Taxes in Prince George's county for enforcing the payment of taxes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That every collector of taxes for Prince George's county, or late collector to whom taxes are due and in arrear, shall be entitled to the following fees; for giving notice and making levy to enforce the payment of any tax bill in his hands for collection, the sum of two dollars and fifty cents, and, in addition thereto, if the property be sold, the collector shall receive as poundage fee four per cent. on the gross amount of sales; but, if the amount of the bill be paid without sale, he shall only receive as poundage fee three per cent. on the amount collected.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

AN ACT to repeal section nine of the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter four hundred and fifteen, entitled "An act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, sections two, three, eight, nine, ten and eleven of chapter two hundred and thirty-three of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled 'An act to establish the Maryland House of Correction,'" and to enact three other sections in lieu of said section nine so repealed.
