Furnish book

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Caroline county shall furnish a proper book for registration, such as may be required by law, to be delivered to the register of voters for said Hillsborough district, or district number six, and said clerk shall also, at the same time, deliver to said register of voters a full list, under seal of his office, of all registered persons or voters appearing on the registration book for the third election district of Caroline county, and the said register of voters of said Hillsborough district, or district number six, shall transcribe from said list, and enter in alphabetical order in said registration book for said Hillsborough district, or district number six, the names of all persons living within the limits thereof entitled to vote in said Hillsborough district, or district number six, and likewise to register therein the names of all persons who shall become entitled to vote in said Hillsborough district, or district number six, according to the laws of this State.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the officer of registration of district number three, sometimes called Denton district, to strike from the list of qualified voters on the registration book thereof, names of all persons residing within the limits of, and entitled to vote in said Hillsborough district, or election district number six.

Inconsistent
acts repealed.

SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That all acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act be and the same are hereby repealed, and that this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
