of Baltimore be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to appropriate money annually for the relief of the "Boys' Home Society of Baltimore," not exceeding the sum of five thousand dollars.

CHAPTER 112.

AN ACT to add an additional sub-section to article twenty-two of the Public Local Laws, title "Worcester county," authorizing the county commissioners of said county, in their discretion, to publish notices or advertisements by means of printed or written handbills, to follow section thirty-nine of article twenty-two, and to be numbered as subsection thirty-nine.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the following additional section be and is hereby added to article twenty-two of the Public Local Laws, relating to Worcester county, to follow section thirty-nine of said article, and to be numbered as sub-section thirty-nine:

Sub-Sec. 39. The County Commissioners of Worcester county, in all cases where they are by law required to give any public notice or notices whatsoever, by advertising in a newspaper or newspapers, are hereby authorized and empowered, in their discretion, either to so advertise, as by law required, or if they think proper in lieu thereof, to give public notice by posting printed or written handbills containing the same matter or facts required to be advertised, in at least three public places in each election district of said county, at the same time or times
