

Repealed. Public General Laws, article thirty-eight, entitled "Fees of Officers," sub-title "Crier," be and the same is hereby repealed in so far as it relates to Dorchester county.

SECTION. The "Crier" of the Circuit Court for Dorchester county shall be entitled to and receive a per diem of two dollars and fifty cents for each and every day he shall be employed as such, which shall be in full, and in lieu of all other allowances now authorized by law; and the Commissioners of Dorchester county are authorized and directed at their next meeting for laying the county levy, and annually thereafter to levy, for the use of the "Crier" of said court, on the assessable property of said county such sum or sums of money as they shall deem sufficient to pay the per diem of the "Crier" of said court for both the general and equity terms thereof; and upon presentation to said county commissioners of the certificate of the clerk of said court, certifying the number of days in which he has been engaged at each term of said court, the "Crier" thereof shall be entitled to receive his per diem in cash, and the said county commissioners are directed upon presentation thereof to pay the same.

Repealed. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That all local laws inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Effective. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect on and after the first day of January, eighteen hundred and eighty-one.
