CHAPTER 128.

AN ACT to amend the act of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter one hundred and eight, incorporating the South Baltimore Chemical Works, by substituting the name of Thomas C. Chappell for that of Philip S. Chappell, now deceased, as a corporator, commissioner and director thereunder.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the first section of the act of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter one hundred and eight, incorporating the South Baltimore "Chemical Work," since named the Chappell Chemical and Fertiliser Company, by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, chapter two hundred and thirty-seven, be and the same is hereby amended by substituting therein for the name of Philip S. Chappell, since deceased, the name of his son, and successor in business, Thomas C. Chappell, of the city of Baltimore.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the said Thomas C. Chappell be and he is hereby substituted for his said deceased father as to all the rights, duties, powers and privileges conferred or assigned to the latter by the said act of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter one hundred and eight, or any section or part thereof, and exercisable by the said Philip S. Chappell in his lifetime, under the said act of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, chapter two hundred and thirty-seven, changing the name of said corporation as aforesaid.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from and immediately after its passage.
