CHAPTER 136.

AN ACT to repeal chapter three hundred and sixty-three of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled an act to incorporate the town of Upper Marlborough, in Prince George's county, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That chapter three hundred and sixty-three of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled an act to incorporate the town of Upper Marlborough, in Prince George's county, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Repealed and re-enacted.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the citizens of the town of Upper Marlborough, in Prince George's county, be and they are hereby created a body corporate by the name of the Commissioners of Upper Marlborough, and that by that name may have perpetual succession, may sue and be sued, and may have and use a common seal.

Created a body politic.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the corporate limits of the town of Upper Marlborough shall be as follows: Commencing at the mouth of the Federal Spring Branch, at its confluence with the Western Branch, and running down and with the meanders of said Western Branch on the south side thereof, and exclusive of said branch to the stream beyond James B. Belts' meadow, then up, and with said stream to the small bridge or culvert on the road
