Sub-Section E. No person who shall obtain a license under this act shall sell or barter any intoxicating, spirituous, vinous or fermented liquors to any minor, except under the written order of his parent, guardian or employer, or to any person intoxicated at the time; but any hotel keeper licensed under this act may sell intoxicating, spirituous or fermented liquor to all other persons, in drinks to be drank upon the premises, but not otherwise; and any storekeeper licensed under the provisions of this act may sell the
