seventy-four, aforesaid, so far as they refer to Fairmount District, number six; Dame's Quarter District, number two, nor Hungary Neck District, number five, of Somerset county, therein mentioned.

CHAPTER 140.

AN ACT to authorize the State Comptroller to issue his warrant on the Treasurer for the payment of one thousand dollars to A. Leo Knott, late State's Attorney for Baltimore city, for professional services rendered by him to the State, in the suit of the State of Maryland vs. The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, for the recovery of unexpended bounty money, the said warrant to be payable out of excess of fees returned by said A. Leo Knott, late State's Attorney for Baltimore, to the Treasurer of the State.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the State Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant on the Treasurer of the State, in favor of A. Leo Knott late State's Attorney for Baltimore city, for one thousand dollars, for professional services rendered by said A. Leo Knott in the case of the State vs. The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, for the recovery of unexpended balance of bounty money, and in which ten thousand six hundred and fifty-two dollars and five cents were recovered for the State; provided that the said warrant shall be paid out of excess of fees returned by the said A. Leo Knott to the Treasurer of the State; this claim, and the proofs on which it is based, having been presented to the Comptroller and reported upon by him.

Comptroller directed to issue warrant to A. Leo Knott.

Proviso.
