CHAPTER 141.

AN ACT to provide for the erection of a free bridge over the Patapsco River upon the Hammond's Ferry road, between Baltimore county and Anne Arundel county, where the old Donaldson's Bridge formerly stood.

Required to erect bridge.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Baltimore county, and the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel county, be and they are hereby authorized, directed and required, to erect and build a substantial bridge over the Patapsco River, at or near the point or place where the Hammond's Ferry was formerly located, and where formerly stood the bridge known as and called Donaldson's Bridge.

How constructed - cost

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That said bridge shall be constructed of solid and substantial materials; provided the cost thereof shall not exceed the sum of four thousand dollars.

Who shall pay.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That the said bridge shall be commenced to be built on or before the first day of July next, and shall be completed with all convenient speed; and the County Commissioners of Baltimore county shall pay one-half the cost of the said bridge, and the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel county shall pay one-half the cost of the said bridge; and the said county commissioners of said respective counties are hereby authorized and empowered to levy in this year upon the assessable property in said counties respectively, such sum or sums of money as may be necessary to

Authorized to levy.
