

CHAPTER 144.

AN ACT to require the County Commissioners of Prince George's county, to pay annually to the Commissioners of the town of Laurel, the amount of the road tax levied or taxed upon property within the limits of said corporation.

Commissioners to pay road tax.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall be the duty of the County Commissioners of Prince George's county, to pay annually to the Commissioners of the town of Laurel, the amount of the road tax levied or taxed upon property within the limits of said corporation, to be appropriated and used by them for the repair and improvement of the roads within said corporate limits.

Effective.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 145.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money for the relief of Benjamin Boon who, whilst in the discharge of his duty as fireman on board of the steamer Leila, was seriously scalded.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, Benjamin Boon, a fireman on the steamer Leila of the Oyster Police Force, whilst in the discharge of his duty was, by an explosion of the boiler of said steamer, seriously and permanently injured; therefore,

Comptroller to draw warrant.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller of the Treasury draw his warrant on the State Treasurer in favor of Benjamin Boon for the sum of two hundred dol-
