the rights and privileges held, or to be held, or enjoyed by the other districts in said county, and the benefits of all laws applicable to Princess Anne District, number one.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty of the registration officer of said Princess Anne District, number one, at his first sitting for the purpose of registering voters, under the laws of this State, to enter and register in the registration book of said Princess Anne District, the names of all legally qualified voters residing in that part of Dames' Quarter District annexed to said Princess Anne District by this act, which are now registered as such voters on the registration book of Dames' Quarter District, so far as he may be able to do so.

SEO. 3. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty of the officer of registration in Dames' Quarter District, number two, to erase from the book of registration in said district, the names of all voters residing within the territory hereby annexed to Princess Anne District, number one.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That all local laws now in force in said districts are continued in force, and nothing in this act shall be construed as repealing any of the local laws in either of the said districts.

## CHAPTER 147.

AN ACT to enable the qualified voters of Frederick county, and the various election districts thereof, to determine by ballot whether spirituous or fermented liquors shall be sold in said county or districts.
