

## CHAPTER 150.

AN ACT to prohibit the granting of license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer, at or within three miles of the village of Savage, in Howard county.

Not lawful  
to issue li-  
cense.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That hereafter it shall not be lawful for the clerk of the Circuit Court of Howard county, to issue a license to any person or persons, to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer, within the village of Savage, in the sixth election district of Howard county, or at any place in the said sixth election district within three miles from the Savage Company's Store House in said village of Savage.

How con-  
strued.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted,* That nothing in this act shall be construed to prevent the issuing of license to persons residing within one quarter of a mile of the Annapolis Junction, a station of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company.

Effective.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 151.

AN ACT to give Garrett county equal educational privileges with the other counties of the State.

Preamble.

WHEREAS the act of the Legislature of Maryland of eighteen hundred and seventy-two erecting the county of Garrett, chapter two hundred and twelve, section two, declares "the inhabitants thereof shall have and enjoy all such rights and privileges as are
