SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall not take effect unless the same be accepted by the holders of a majority of the stock of the said "Grant Coal and Coal Oil and Lumber Company," at a meeting of said stockholders, but in case of the acceptance of this act by said stockholders at such meeting, this act shall forthwith go into full effect and operation.

CHAPTER 158.

AN ACT to empower the County Commissioners of Washington county to pay the sum of four thousand five hundred dollars, as evidenced by the existence of certain unpaid bonds issued under the act of eighteen hundred and sixty-six, chapter nineteen.

Preamble.

WHEREAS by an act of the General Assembly of the State of Maryland, passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and sixty-six, chapter nineteen, the County Commissioners of Washington county were authorized to issue bonds to the amount of one hundred and fifty thousand dollars; and whereas the said issue of bonds having been called in, the existence of an over-issue of said bonds representing the sum of four thousand five hundred dollars has been discovered in the hands of innocent holders.

Authorized to pay.

SECTION 1. *Therefore be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Washington county be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to pay said sum of four thousand five hundred dollars, as represented by the bonds aforesaid.
