wild water fowl within the limits of Worcester county.

Capture with nets.

SUB-SECTION 2. And be it enacted, That no person shall, at any time, capture with nets any wild water fowl within the limits of Worcester county.

Hours between twilight. Sub-Section 3. And be it enacted, That no person shall, during the hours intervening between twilight in the evening and twilight of the following morning, shoot or kill, or shoot at, by firelight, any wild water fowl within the limits of Worcester county.

Except from shore.

SUB-SECTION 4. And be it enacted, That no person shall, during the hours intervening between twilight in the evening and twilight of the following morning, shoot or kill, or shoot at any wild water fowl except from the shore, within the limits of Worcester county.

CHAPTER 161.

AN ACT to repeal sections four, six and seven of article nine of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Assignments of choses in action," and to re-enact said sections with amendments.

Repealed and re-enacted.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sections four, six and seven of article nine of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Assignments of choses in action," be and the same are hereby repealed, and said sections are hereby re-enacted to read as follows:

Plaintiff shall die.

SEC. 4. When the legal plaintiff in any suit entered for the use of any person shall die before or after judgment, the person for whose use the same may be entered, or who may be entitled to the same, or his
