CHAPTER 165.

AN ACT to authorize and require the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel county to build a Bridge over the Severn River, in Anne Arundel county, and to provide by taxation already levied or to be levied, the means for building the same.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel county be and they are hereby authorized and required to cause a good and substantial bridge for travel for man or beast, to be constructed across the Severn River, in Anne Arundel county, from the present public or county wharf in Annapolis, situated at the foot of the street commonly called and known as "Wagner street," to Ferry Bar, on the opposite side of the river, or at such point on said river as in the opinion of said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall be most practical and convenient, and most conducive to the interest of the public of North Severn and Annapolis city, and they are hereby authorized to adopt such plans and to make such contracts and to do such acts as may be necessary for the erection, construction and completion of said bridge.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said commissioners, in causing said bridge to be built, shall have the same provided with a suitable and sufficient draw-bridge over the navigable part of said river of a width of not less than sixty feet, for safe and secure passing and repassing of vessels and steamers navigating the same.
