SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the school house provided for by the preceding section of this act shall be erected within six months from the date of the passage of this act, and be paid for upon completion of the same. Shall be erected

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the said school commissioners be and they are hereby constituted and appointed as the building committee to contract for and superintend the construction of said school house. Building committee.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

CHAPTER 169.

AN ACT to encourage the development of manufacturers and manufacturing industry in the city of Havre-de-Grace.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Mayor and City Council of Havre-de-Grace are authorized and empowered, whenever it shall seem expedient for the encouragement of the growth and development of manufacturers and manufacturing industry in said city, to provide by general ordinance for the abatement of any or all taxes levied by authority of said Mayor and City Council, or any ordinance thereof, for any of the corporate uses thereof, upon any mechanical tools or implements, whether worked by hand or by steam, or other motive power machinery; manu- Encouragement of manufacturing industry
