SEC. 6. *And be it further enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage, subject nevertheless to all the conditions and limitations in reference to the provisions of said act which are therein set forth.

CHAPTER 17.

AN ACT to repeal section one hundred and two of article twenty-one, Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Fish," and amend and re-enact the same so as to read as follows:

Not to fish in Israel's creek

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, No person or persons shall in any manner or way, except by hook and line, fish in the waters of Israel's creek, in Washington county, from the date of the passage of this act until the first of April, eighteen hundred and eighty-five.

Fine for violation.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted*, Any person or persons violating the preceding section shall pay a fine of five dollars for each and every such offence, to be recovered before a Justice of the Peace of said county, one-half of which fine shall be paid to the county commissioners for the use of the public schools of said county, and the other half to the informer of such violation.

Effective.

SEC. 3. *Be it enacted*, This act to take effect from the date of its passage.
