

Name changed Industrial School for Girls" be and the same is hereby changed to the name "The Female House of Refuge," which is hereby fixed and established in perpetuity as the corporate name of said institution.

Made applicable. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the provisions of section eighteen and section twenty-one of article seventy-eight of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Refuge, House of" (as amended by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, chapter two hundred and eighteen), be and the same are hereby made applicable to this institution throughout the State.

Inure to the benefit of SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That all legacies now existing or hereafter given by persons dying after the date of this act, and all appropriations made, or hereafter to be made, by the General Assembly of Maryland, or by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, and intended for this institution, but given or made by its former name of "The Maryland Industrial School for Girls," instead of its name as fixed by this act, shall remain and inure to the benefit of "The Female House of Refuge."

Effective. SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 174.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Baltimore county to dispose of the Maryland Defence Loan bonds owned by said county, and reinvest the same, or so much thereof as may be required, to purchase a piece of land adjoining the county almshouse.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Board of County Com-
