

and the boat, gun or guns, ammunition, and all other property found in the possession or use of such person or persons at the time of the arrest shall be held until such fine is paid; one-half of said fine to go to the informer, the other half to the school fund of the county in which the offence was committed.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act be and the same are hereby repealed, and that this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 177.

AN ACT to repeal chapter forty-five of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, entitled "An act to permit the shooting of 'wild fowl' from sink boxes in the waters of 'Talbot county,'" and to enact the following in lieu thereof:

Repealed and enacted in lieu.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That chapter forty-five of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, entitled "An act to permit the shooting of 'wild fowl' from sink boxes in the waters of 'Talbot county,'" be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following enacted in lieu thereof:

Who is allowed to shoot.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted*, That it shall be lawful for the bona fide citizens of Talbot county to shoot "wild fowl" from sink boxes in the waters of said county, inclusive of the waters of Eastern Bay; provided that the waters where said boxes are used shall not be less than three hundred yards in width.

SEC. 3. No person shall, during the hours intervening between twilight at evening and twilight of the following morning, shoot or kill, or shoot at, by
