CHAPTER 182.

AN ACT to authorize the burgess and commissioners of the town of Emmettsburg, in Frederick county, to prohibit stock from running at large in said town.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the burgess and commissioners of the town of Emmettsburg, in Frederick county, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, in their discretion, to provide by ordinance to prohibit stock from running at large upon the streets or within the limits of said town, and to enforce the provisions of said ordinance, by the imposition of just and reasonable fines.
