CHAPTER 184.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Caroline county to build, erect and construct the necessary fire-proof vaults for the preservation of the records and court papers of the Circuit and 'Orphans' Courts of said county, and to levy taxes upon the assessable property of said county for the payment of the same.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Caroline county be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, in their discretion, to contract for and superintend the construction of fire-proof vaults in the court-house of said county, for the preservation of the records and court papers of the Circuit and Orphans' Courts of said county.

Construct fire-proof vaults.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That said county commissioners shall levy upon the assessable property of said county taxes sufficient for the erection and construction of said fire-proof vaults.

Levy on assessable property.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act take effect from the date of its passage.
