## CHAPTER 185.

AN ACT to amend section eighty of chapter four hundred and seventy-one of the acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled "An act to repeal article twenty-six of the Code of Public General Laws," and to enact a substitute therefor, and to repeal section twenty-two of article sixteen, sections ninety-nine to one hundred and three of the same article, and sections thirty-three to forty-three of article eighty-eight of the Code of Public General Laws," relating to cemetery companies.

Repealed and re-enacted.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section eighty of chapter four hundred and seventy-one of the acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled "An act to repeal article twenty-six of the Code of Public General Laws," relating to corporations, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Lanes, &c, prohibited through cemeteries.

80. No lanes, alleys, streets, roads, canals or public thoroughfares of any sort shall be opened through the property of any cemetery company incorporated under the provisions of this article, which is used or appropriated for the purpose of burial, but nothing herein contained shall authorize any such corporation to obstruct any public road, street or lane actually opened and used as such at the time of its incorporation, or then laid down on any plat made by authority of the State or city, town or county, to be opened as a street or road; provided that no cemetery company, incorporated under the provisions of this article, shall establish, have or maintain, for the purpose of burial, any ground within the distance of one thousand yards from any boundary line of Druid Hill Park, nor permit any interment therein, nor shall any funeral or burial procession to or from any cemetery incorporated under the provisions of this article pass through any part of said Druid Hill Park, without the permission in writing of the Park Com-
