

and commissions to be paid by the applicants for license, in addition to the sum to be paid for said license.

Guilty of a misdemeanor

SEC. 139. Any distiller of spirituous or fermented liquors or spirits who shall sell, deliver or give to any person any quantity of spirituous or fermented liquor or distilled spirits, less than five wine gallons, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be liable to a fine of not less than fifty nor more than one hundred dollars for each offence, in the discretion of the court, and imprisonment in the county jail for thirty days.

Not to be drunk on premises

SEC. 140. Any person obtaining license under the provisions of this act to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer, selling the same in quantities of one pint and more, shall not allow the said spirituous or fermented liquor or lager beer to be drunk on his or her premises; and any person violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon indictment and conviction thereof shall be fined not less than ten nor more than fifty dollars, and imprisoned not less than one nor more than three months, for each offence.

Liable for reasonable compensation.

SEC. 141. Whoever, by the sale of intoxicating liquors contrary to law, causes the intoxication of another person, shall be liable for and compelled to pay a reasonable compensation to any person who may take charge of, and provide for, such intoxicated person, and one dollar per day in addition thereto, for every day such intoxicated person may be kept in consequence of such intoxication; which sum may be recovered in a civil action before any court or justice of the peace having jurisdiction thereof, and said suit may be brought upon the bond of any person obtaining license under the provisions of this act, and shall be liable for the sum recovered in said suit, in case the sale is made by a person who has obtained license under the provisions of this act.

Right of action.

SEC. 142. Every husband, wife, child, parent, guardian or other person, injured in person or property, or means of support, by any intoxicated person, or in consequence of the intoxication, habitual or other-
