license laws of this State, relating to the sale of spirituous and fermented liquors and lager beer, and upon conviction, in addition to any penalties inflicted by said laws, it shall be the duty of the court before whom such person shall be convicted, to suppress his or her license, and for the period of one year after such suppression no license to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer shall be granted to the person so convicted, or to any person for the use or benefit, directly or indirectly, of such convict, and no license shall be granted to any one to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer on the premises where such offence was committed during the time for which the suppressed license was granted, and any license obtained contrary to the provisions of this act shall be void.

When licenses are void.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

Inconsistent acts repealed.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from and after the first day of May next.

## CHAPTER 189.

AN ACT to repeal section ninety two of article twelve of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Harford county," sub-title "Orphans' Court," and re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section ninety-two of article twelve of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Harford county," sub-title "Orphans' Court," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:
