Clerk to copy
index.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the clerk of the Circuit Court for Talbot county be and he is hereby authorized to copy said index in a good and substantial book, from eighteen hundred and sixty-four to eighteen hundred and seventy-three inclusive.

Levy to pay.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the commissioners of said county be and they are hereby authorized to levy upon the assessable property of said county a sufficient sum to pay the expenses of recopying as aforesaid.

CHAPTER 194.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact section two of chapter forty-one of the acts passed at January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, entitled "An act to protect Fish and Wild Fowl in Romney creek, in Harford county.

Repealed and
re-enacted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section two of chapter forty-one of the acts passed at January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, entitled "An act to protect Fish and Wild Fowl in the waters of Romney creek," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

Unlawful to
whip or beat
waters.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That it shall not be lawful for any person to whip or beat the waters of Romney creek, in Harford county, with poles, sticks, or any other thing for the purpose of driving fish into seines, fish baskets or any other contrivance
