all their title to the capital stock of the said Annapolis and Elk Ridge Railroad Company, and all their claims and demands upon or against the same.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the extension of time hereby given for the completion of the roads shall not be construed, in any way, as to bind the county of Anne Arundel for its subscription to the capital stock of said company, unless the county commissioners give their consent to a continuance of said subscription.

How construed.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, and that all acts and parts of acts repugnant thereto, or in conflict therewith, shall then and thenceforward be repealed and of no effect.

## CHAPTER 201.

AN ACT to authorize the consolidation of the Baltimore and Drum Point Railroad Company and the Annapolis and Elk Ridge Railroad Company, by the merger of the latter in the former corporation.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Baltimore and Drum Point Railroad Company and the Annapolis and Elk Ridge Railroad Company, two corporations created and existing under the laws of this State, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to unite and consolidate themselves together, by merging the said Annapolis and Elk Ridge Railroad Company in the said Baltimore and Drum Point Railroad Company, upon such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon by and between the stockholders of the said corporations, at general meetings

Unite and consolidate.
