

sion of the General Assembly of Maryland; provided the same be not otherwise defective for reasons other than the want of jurisdiction, but after the consummation of the change of boundary lines as aforesaid, any official act arising from business brought before them after such change shall have reference to Caroline county only and not to Dorchester county.

Take census      SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That Edw'd R. Goslin and Henry P. Chambers be and they are hereby appointed to take the census of the qualified voters of Dorchester county residing within the limits defined in section one of this act, and in event of the death of one the other shall act alone, and they shall, under oath, to be taken before a justice of the peace in said district number twelve of Dorchester county, make a careful list of all male citizens over the age of twenty-one years and otherwise qualified to vote in said district, who reside within the limits of the territory defined in section one of this act, and return two correct copies thereof to the judges of election of said district before the aforesaid day of election, who shall permit all persons whose names shall appear on said list, and none others, to vote, as prescribed in section six of this act, and who shall return said copies, together with their certificates of the result of the election, one to the Governor of this State and the other to the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Dorchester county.
