CHAPTER 210.

AN ACT to amend article twenty-eight of the Code of Public General Laws of this State, title "County Commissioners," by adding an additional section thereto under said title, to be designated as section one A, relating to the method of filling vacancies or otherwise in the number of county commissioners for each county.

Additional section added Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That article twenty-eight of the Code of Public General Laws of this State, title "County Commissioners," be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following additional section under said title, to be designated as section one A.

Vacancy how filled 1 A. In case any office of county commissioner shall become vacant in any county by death, resignation or otherwise, the Governor, if such vacancy shall occur during the session of the Senate shall, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, appoint; and if such vacancy shall occur during the recess of the Senate, shall appoint a proper person or proper persons to fill such vacancy or vacancies; and the nomination of the person thus appointed during such recess, or of some other person in his place, shall be made to the Senate within thirty days after the next meeting of the Legislature.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
