the said board of county commissioners upon the assessable property in said county as other county expenses are.

Effective.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 214.

AN ACT to repeal sections two and four of the act passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter two hundred and seventy-seven, entitled an act to repeal chapter seventy-seven of the laws passed in eighteen hundred and seventy-four, relating to oysters in the waters comprised within the limits of Worcester county, and to re-enact the same with amendments, and also to protect fish therein, and to enact a substitute therefor.

Repealed and re-enacted.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sections two and four of the act passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter two hundred and seventy-seven, relating to the protection of oysters in Synepuxent bay and its tributaries, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

May issue lisenso. SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the clerk of the Circuit Court for Worcester county may issue to any citizen of said county a license to take or catch oysters with rakes or tongs, from the waters of Synepuxent bay and its tributaries, until the first day of May next after the issuing of said license; provided the applicant for said license shall satisfy said clerk
