CHAPTER 220.

AN ACT to pay Mrs. Mary Denney, of Howard county, back pension due her.

WHEREAS Mary Denney, of Howard county, the daughter of a soldier of the revolutionary war, was entitled to a pension from the State, but by an omission her name was not put upon the pension rolls; therefore—

Preamble

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller of the State is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant to the Treasurer, to pay to Mary Denney, of Howard county, an annual pension of eighty dollars, beginning from the first day of January, eighteen hundred and seventy, to January first, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight.

CHAPTER 221.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county to regulate travel over the bridges in said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to make such by-laws, rules,
