CHAPTER 23.

AN ACT to repeal chapter one hundred and ninety-eight of the acts passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Somerset county to levy a sum of money to build a bridge over Monumsko Creek, in said county," and re-enact the same so as to read as follows:

Authorized to build bridge. Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Somerset county be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, if in their discretion they shall deem it necessary for the convenience of the public, to build a bridge across Monumsko Creek of such width as in their discretion may be necessary, and of such height as may be sufficient to allow the passage thereunder of such boats as may navigate the said creek at the place of said bridge. The said bridge to be located at such place as the said county commissioners may deem best, in their discretion, for the convenience of the public to be benefitted thereby.

Authorized to levy.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That for the purpose of building said bridge the said county commissioners are hereby authorized to levy a sum of money upon the assessable property of said county not exceeding one thousand dollars.
