orders and regulations (not inconsistent with the laws of this State) as shall be necessary for the protection of bridges in Queen Anne's county; and any person or persons violating any of the said by-laws, rules, orders or regulations relating to the rate of speed, by driving over any of the bridges in said county at a rate of speed faster than a walk, shall forfeit and pay to the said county commissioners the sum of one dollar for each and every offence in so offending, to be recovered before any justice of the peace in said county in the name of the county commissioners aforesaid, and on refusal to pay said fine and costs, he or they shall be committed by such justice of the peace to the jail of Queen Anne's county until the same are paid.

Fines—how disposed of.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That all fines collected under this act shall be paid to the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county; and the said county commissioners are hereby authorized to use such money for the purpose of keeping the bridges in said county in repair.

CHAPTER 222.

AN ACT to repeal section thirty-four of article sixteen of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Chancery," sub-title "Dower," and to amend and re-enact the same.

Repealed and re enacted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section thirty-four of article sixteen of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Chancery," sub-title "Dower," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Widow's dower.

SECTION 34. Where there is a decree for the sale of lands, and a widow is entitled to dower therein,
