Loan," issued under the provisions of the act of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, chapter two hundred and thirty-five.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That the special tax of five and a half cents levied by and under the fifth section of the said act of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, chapter two hundred and thirty-five, be and the same is hereby continued, and said tax shall be annually levied, collected and paid over to the Treasurer until the debt created by this act shall be paid, and a separate and distinct account shall be kept thereof, and the proceeds thereof are hereby further pledged and appropriated to meet the interest on and create a sinking fund, to consist of the bonds or certificates of debt of this State, or of the United States, for the redemption of the certificates of debt or bonds that may be issued under the provisions of this act.

Special tax continued.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That no further certificates of debt or bonds shall be issued under the act of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, chapter two hundred and thirty-five.

CHAPTER 233.

AN ACT to authorize the Board of County School Commissioners of Worcester county to appropriate money belonging to the Free School Fund of said county towards building school houses and for other purposes.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Board of County School Commissioners of Worcester county be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to appropriate and use, out of the Free School Fund
