perty of said county, such sums as may be necessary to pay for the work prescribed above.

Compensation. SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That from and after the passage of this act, the clerk of the Circuit Court for Queen Anne's county shall be entitled to demand and receive from any person or persons or body corporate, depositing in his office for record any deed or writing relating to the conveyance or transfer of real estate or personal property, the sum of five cents for each name appearing as a party to such deed or writing, for the purpose of continuing said general index.

## CHAPTER 241.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county to levy a sum of money as a pension for Solomon Tate, of said county.

Levy for pension. SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county be and they are hereby authorized, in their discretion, to levy upon the assessable property of said county for the sum of thirty dollars for the year of eighteen hundred and eighty, and the same amount for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-one, as a pension for Solomon Tate, of said county.
