

CHAPTER 260.

AN ACT to repeal chapter two hundred and seventy-six of the acts passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to repeal an act passed at the session of the General Assembly of Maryland in eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter two hundred and fifty-two, entitled 'An act to repeal an act passed at the session of the General Assembly of Maryland in eighteen hundred and seventy-four, chapter four hundred and twenty-one,' entitled 'An act to repeal section two of article forty-one of the Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Fish and Fisheries,'" and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to substitute the following in lieu thereof, and to amend and re-enact so as to read as follows, and to amend and re-enact the same as amended.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the act passed at the session of the General Assembly, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter two hundred and seventy-six, entitled "An act to repeal an act passed at the session of the General Assembly of Maryland, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter two hundred and fifty-two, entitled 'An act to repeal an act passed at the session of the General Assembly in eighteen hundred and seventy-four, chapter four hundred and twenty-one of the Public General Laws of Maryland,' title 'Fish and Fisheries,'" and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to substitute the following in lieu thereof, be and the same is hereby repealed, amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows :
