

Issue warrant is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer to pay George W. Dorsey, late Collector of State Taxes in Baltimore county, the sum of twenty-six dollars and nine cents (\$26.09), being the amount overpaid by said George W. Dorsey into the treasury as collector of State taxes for the twelfth district of Baltimore county, for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-five, as certified to by the Comptroller and Treasurer, the refunding thereof having received the recommendation of said officers.

Effective **SEC. 2.** *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 263.

AN ACT to repeal section forty-nine of chapter one hundred and eight of the Acts of Assembly, passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled an act to add an additional section to the Code of "Public Local Laws," to be entitled "Garrett county," and to re-enact the same with amendments, limiting the jurisdiction of "Justices of the Peace."

Repealed and re-enacted. **SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section forty-nine of chapter one hundred and eight of the Acts of Assembly, passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

When unlawful. **SEC. 49.** It shall not be lawful for any resident of Garrett county to be sued before any justice of the peace in said county out of the election district in which said resident resides; provided, however,
