

induce any person to enter upon the land of another and cut down without the permission of the owner of said land, or cut down upon the lands of another, with intent to appropriate to his or her own use any timber or tree of a size not less than those commonly used for hoop poles, in Garrett county, said person so offending, his or her aiders and abettors, shall be adjudged guilty of felony, and shall be sentenced as for feloniously stealing goods or chattels to the value of the tree or trees which shall be cut down as aforesaid.

#### CHAPTER 265.

AN ACT to give and declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest of one hundred dollars contained in the last will and testament of John Wintermeier, late of Allegany county, Maryland, deceased, to the St. Peter and Paul's Church, at Cumberland, in Allegany county, State of Maryland.

**Sanction and consent given** SECTION 1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby given and declared to the bequest of one hundred dollars, contained in the last will and testament of John Wintermeier, late of Allegany county, deceased, to the St. Peter and Paul's Church at Cumberland, Allegany county, State of Maryland, and which said will is duly of probate and record in the Orphans' Court of said Allegany county.

**Effective.** SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
