Be it enacted, That all acts of said corporation done by it in which the name of Thomas Wildey Lodge, number forty-four, of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows, was used, be and the same are hereby made good and valid as the same would have been if said charter had been in force in said last mentioned name at the time of doing said act.

Hold and possess property SEC. 3. Be it enacted, That said corporation be and it is hereby authorized to hold and possess property, real, personal and mixed, to the value of ten thousand dollars, in the name of Thomas Wildey Lodge, number forty-four, of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 270.

AN ACT to refund to Ambrose Cooly certain money erroneously paid by him into the treasury.

Issue war-

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant on the Treasurer in favor of Ambrose Cooly, late collector of State taxes in the second district of Harford county, for the sum of eleven dollars and eighty-three cents, erroneously paid by him into the State Treasury, as certified to by the Comptroller and Treasurer.

Effective. Show 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
