Power to collect debts due next thereafter, for the purpose of winding up its affairs and the proper application and distribution of its assets, and for which they may exercise all the corporate powers heretofore granted to said corporation with full power to collect all debts due to it by suit or otherwise, and in like manner, from time to time, to do all other corporate acts necessary for the distribution of all its outstanding assets.

How to wind up.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That such winding up, and all other matters appertaining to such corporation, shall be ordered and directed by the Board of Directors, hereafter annually to be chosen by the stockholders, in accordance with the requirements of the charter as it now exists, and such other laws of the State of Maryland, since enacted that may be applicable thereto, who shall bring the affairs of said corporation to a close, and in case of the death or resignation of any director, the remaining directors shall fill all vacancies.

Effective.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 30.

AN ACT to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest of Archibald Chisholm, late of Garrett county, deceased, to the Board of Foreign Missions of the Presbyterian church of the United States of America.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Archibald Chisholm, late of Garrett county, deceased, by his last will and testament, duly executed, admitted to probate in the office of the Register of Wills for Garrett county aforesaid, devised and bequeathed certain property therein mentioned to the Board of Foreign Missions of the
