He shall be entitled to thirty-five cents a day for each prisoner committed to the jail of said county, and to the following sums for taking convicts to the penitentiary, to wit: When a single convict is taken, thirty-five dollars; when two together, twenty-five dollars each; when more than two, twenty dollars each; to be levied as other county charges.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the first day of January, eighteen hundred and eighty-one.

CHAPTER 286.

AN ACT to add new sections to the Code of Public Local Laws, article one, entitled "Allegany county," sub-title "Roads."

Additional sections

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the following sections are hereby added to article one of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Allegany county," sub-title "Roads."

Appoint general road supervisor.

SEC. —. The county commissioners of said county are hereby authorized and empowered, in the month of April, eighteen hundred and eighty, and in each second year thereafter, to appoint one person, a resident of said county and qualified voter therein, to be known as General Supervisor of Roads, whose duty it shall be to take charge of the public roads and bridges of said county, and superintend the building and repairs of all such public roads and bridges, subject to the control and supervision of said commissioners in all respects; and said commissioners shall have full power to make rules and regulations fixing and determining the duties of said supervisor and the manner of performing the same; and said supervisor shall hold office for the term of
