

CHAPTER 290.

AN ACT to amend the act to incorporate a company for the establishment of a Public Cemetery of Elkton, Maryland, passed by the General Assembly of Maryland, and approved April eighth, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter three hundred and seventy-four.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the President and Managers of the Elkton Cemetery shall have power to designate the person or persons who, in their judgment, are proper and qualified to be entrusted with the digging, filling and walling of graves and making all excavations for burial purposes in their said cemetery grounds, and to prohibit said work from being done by any other person.
