

Number of justices. SECTION 25. There shall be the following number of Justices of the Peace and Constables for Howard county, to wit: for election district number one, three Justices of the Peace and two Constables; for election district number two, three Justices of the Peace and two Constables; for election district number three, four Justices of the Peace and two Constables; for election district number four, three Justices of the Peace and two Constables; for election district number five, three Justices of the Peace and two Constables; for election district number six, three Justices of the Peace and two Constables; and that any and all official acts heretofore done by any of the Justices of the Peace or of any of the Constables heretofore appointed for election district number four, of said county, since the twenty-seventh day of March, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, be and the same are hereby made valid.

Made valid.

Effective. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
