SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That after the passage of this act, all voters residing west of this line who, heretofore, voted at Grantsville, in election district number three, shall, after having been duly registered upon the registration books of election district number five, be entitled to vote at all elections hereafter to be held at Accident, in election district number five.

CHAPTER 310.

AN ACT to authorize and require the County Commissioners of Baltimore county to change the names of the streets running parallel with Boundary avenue and north thereof, and to designate the same by numbers.

Change name
of streets.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Commissioners of Baltimore county be and they are hereby authorized and required to change the name of Denmead street, and all other streets running parallel with and north of Boundary avenue, into first, second and third streets, and so on, so that the same may hereafter be designated by numerals.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after its passage.
