

Notify parties.

sheriff of Washington county, who shall notify the person or persons to whom the notice is directed, by reading the same to him or them, and return said order to the said commissioners, with the day and date of the giving of said notice to the person or persons therein mentioned endorsed upon the same.

Fine for non-compliance.

SEC. 234 C. Upon refusal or neglect of such person or persons to comply with the orders of the said commissioners within ninety days from the date of said notice as returned by the sheriff, any person so refusing or neglecting to comply with said orders shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and after presentment and indictment by a grand jury, upon the conviction thereof, shall be fined the sum of five dollars per day for each and every day that said fence or other obstruction shall remain after the expiration of ninety days from the date of the giving of said notice, together with all costs incurred, the said fine to be recovered in the manner provided by law for the recovery of fines, penalties and forfeitures, and to be paid to the said county commissioners for the use of the roads of said county.

AN ACT to appropriate the sum of thirty-three dollars and seventy-two cents to pay John H. Thomas, late collector of State taxes in Kent county, said amount overpaid by him into the treasury.

Issue warrant

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the treasurer to pay John H. Thomas, late collector of State taxes for the first district of Kent county, the sum of thirty three dollars and seventy-
