CHAPTER 318.

AN ACT to fix the compensation of the sheriff of Montgomery county for keeping and boarding prisoners committed to the jail of said county.

Amount allowed.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sheriff of Montgomery county be and is hereby allowed thirty cents a day, and no more, for keeping and boarding each prisoner committed to the jail of said county.

Effective.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 319.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Charles county to levy a sum of money to provide payment for indexing certain records in the office of the Register of Wills of said county.

Pay for indexing. Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Charles county be and they are hereby authorized to levy a sum of money, not exceeding two hundred dollars, to make payment in full to Marcellus Thompson, late Register of Wills of said county, for indexing certain records in office of Register of Wills of said county, if in the discretion of said county commissioners such payment is just and proper.

Effective.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
