preceding section, shall have the right to appeal from said judgment to the Circuit Court for Washington county.

CHAPTER 323.

AN ACT to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore city to make annual appropriations for the benefit of the "Maryland Industrial School for Girls."

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore are hereby authorized and empowered to appropriate annually, towards the current expenses of the "Maryland Industrial School for Girls," any sum or sums of money not exceeding three thousand dollars, per annum; and the said Mayor and City Council are further authorized and empowered to appropriate for repairs, permanent improvements and additions to the buildings now occupied and used by said "Maryland Industrial School for Girls," such additional sum or sums of money as in their judgment shall from time to time be required for these purposes.
